"AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND OPERATING EXPENSES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ARKANSAS HERITAGE FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1991; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 49. TRANSFER OF STATE FUNDS - HISTORIC PRESERVATION PROGRAM. Subject to such rules and regulations as may be implemented by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and after seeking prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council, the Historic Preservation Officer is hereby authorized to transfer funds and appropriations for Regular Salaries; Personal Services Matching (Social Security, Retirement, Workmen's Compensation and Unemployment Insurance) Maintenance and Operations; Grants; Conference Fees and Travel; Professional Services; and Extra Help; under the various sections in this Act which appropriate State Funds, whenever it appears by projecting the expenditures of any of these appropriations that there will be a need of funds or appropriations in one item and that there is an excess of funds or appropriations in another item. The transfer of appropriations and funds shall be effected only upon approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, who will then authorize the State Treasurer and State Auditor to adjust the effected accounts on their books of record respectively.

SECTION 50. In addition to any other rights, powers, functions and duties granted by law to the Department of Arkansas Heritage, the Department is hereby authorized to promote and cooperate in the establishment under the Arkansas non-profit corporation laws of a Heritage Foundation, to share resources and facilities with the foundation and to accept support and assistance in the form of money, property or otherwise from the foundation to be used to preserve and promote the heritage of the State.

SECTION 51. If a Heritage Foundation is established and the Department shares resources or facilities with the Foundation or accepts support and assistance from the Foundation, the Foundation shall annually file a report with the Governor, the Legislative Council, and the Legislative Joint Auditing committee showing the amount and source of all gifts, grants, and donations of money or property received by the Foundation and all expenditures or other dispositions of money or property by the Foundation during the preceding year.

SECTION 52. The Director of the Department of Arkansas Heritage shall, on or before July 1 of each fiscal year, submit a plan to the Arkansas Legislative Council reflecting the proposed uses of private funds for the ensuing fiscal year for its review and comment. No person over which the Department of Arkansas Heritage has day to day managerial control, shall receive compensation or remuneration from funds not in the State Treasury.

SECTION 53. STATE SEAL. No monies may be expended by the Department of Arkansas Heritage for the purchase of any state printing contract item, until the Great Seal of the State of Arkansas is placed on the letterhead of all agencies and commissions within the Department of Arkansas Heritage.

SECTION 54. The following positions; (A) 1 (one) N370 Architectural Historian Grade 20; (B) 1 (one) R266 Management Project Analyst II Grade 19 authorized in Section 48 of this Act shall be financed by any increase in the Real Estate Transfer Tax enacted by the 76th General Assembly and made available to the Arkansas Natural and Cultural Resources Council for the "Main

SECTION 55. Provided, however, that no employee of the Commemorative Commission of the Department of Arkansas Heritage who is employed as "Extra Help" may receive an amount to exceed seventy-five percent (75%) of the maximum annual salary for a comparable position as authorized by Arkansas Code 21-5-201 et seq. during any fiscal year, nor shall such employee be employed for a period of time to exceed fifteen hundred (1500) hours in any single fiscal year.

SECTION 56. Members of the Natural Heritage Commission shall serve without compensation, except that they shall be paid, from any monies available, a per diem allowance of fifty dollars (\$50.00) while actually in attendance at meetings of the commission or engaged in business of the commission certified as necessary by the chairman. In addition to the per diem, members shall be paid a mileage allowance equal to the rate designated for state employees for each mile in traveling from their home and return.

SECTION 57. NATURAL AND CULTURAL RESOURCES COUNCIL. The Director of the Department of Arkansas Heritage shall be the disbursing officer for the appropriations provided by Sections 46 and 47 of this Act. Further, if grants are made to state agencies from the appropriations provided by Sections 46 and 47 herein, the corresponding amount of appropriation and funding of such grant may be transferred to such state agency for use in classifications of expenditures as determined by conditions of the grant and the state agency.

SECTION 58. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 59. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 60. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 61. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the Seventy-Seventh General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1989 is essential to the

operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1989 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1989.
