Section 26-75-207 of the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated is 17 hereby amended to read as follows: "26-75-207. Levying of tax. 18 (a) The governing body of any city may adopt an ordinance levying a 19 20 local sales and use tax in the amount of one-fourth of one percent, one-half 21 of one percent, three-fourths of one percent or one percent for the benefit of 22 such city in accordance with the provisions of this subchapter. The governing body of the city by such levying ordinance may, but 23 24 shall not be required to, provide for an expiration date for such local sales 25 and use tax. The sales tax portion of any local sales and use tax adopted under 26 27 this subchapter shall be levied by the governing body on the receipts from the 28 sale at retail within the city of all items which are subject to taxation 29 under the Arkansas Gross Receipts Act, 26-52-101 et seq." 30 SECTION 2. Subsection (b) of Section 26-75-208 of the Arkansas Code of 31 32 1987 Annotated is hereby amended to read as follows: "(b) The ballot title to be used at such election shall be 33 34 substantially in the following form: 'FOR adoption of a percent (%) local sales and use tax 35 []

36 within(name of city).'

 If an expiration date for the local sales and use tax has been provided
 4 for by the governing body of the city in the levying ordinance as described in
 5 § 26-75-207(b), the ballot title shall also include an expiration date for the
 6 levy of the tax, and, if adopted in this form, the tax shall cease to be
7 levied on the date noted on the ballot.
         The election shall be conducted in the manner provided by law for all
 9 other municipal elections unless otherwise specified in this subchapter."

         SECTION 3. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature
12 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
13 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

         SECTION 4. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to
16 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
17 other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without
18 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
19 Act are declared to be severable.

         SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are
22 hereby repealed.
         SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
23
24 General Assembly that the provisions of Title 26, Chapter 75, Subchapter 2 of
25 the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated authorizing the levy of a local sales and
26 use tax by municipalities to levy such tax for a prescribed and limited period
27 of time, and that this Act is immediately necessary to so provide. Therefore,
28 an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being immediately
29 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be
30 in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
