Title 22, Chapter 3, Subchapter 13 of the Arkansas Code of 1987 is hereby amended by adding a new section to read as follows: "22-3-1312. (a) Should a state agency operate or develop as an 17 integral part of its student program, a food service training program, the 18 19 state agency administrator or governing board of the state-supported facility shall notify the licensing agency of the program change. 21 (b) The licensing agency shall contract with the state agency 22 administrator or governing board of the state-supported facility for any 23 continuance of the vending facility located at the state agency. Such 24 continuance shall provide for the existence of both the food service student 25 training program and the vending facility, if possible. The State Licensing 26 Agency shall determine the feasibility of such continuance." 27 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature 28 29 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code 30 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 31 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to 32 33 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect 34 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 35 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this 36 act are declared to be severable.

2	SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
3	hereby repealed.
4	
5	SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
6	Seventy-Eighth General Assembly that clarification needs to be provided in
7	existing law concerning the affect of student program changes on licensed
8	vending facilities operated by blind persons. That this act provides such
9	clarification and also provides a mechanism for resolution of the current
10	situation. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this act
11	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
12	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and
13	approval.
