**A BILL ACT 1036 OF 1991**  
**HOUSE BILL 2090**

**For An Act To Be Entitled**

8 "AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE LEGISLATIVE INTENT ON THE USE OF  
9 EDUCATIONAL TRUST FUNDS AND WEIGHTED INSTRUCTIONAL  
10 PROGRAMS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

11

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

13

14 SECTION 1. Educational Trust Fund monies established under Act 10 of  
15 1991, shall not be subject to expenditure requirements for weighted  
16 instructional programs pursuant to A.C.A. §§6-20-315, 6-20-316 and 6-20-317.

18 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
19 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
20 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

22 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
23 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
24 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
25 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
26 act are declared to be severable.

27

28 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
29 hereby repealed.

30

31 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the  
32 Seventy-Eighth General Assembly that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1,  
33 1991 is essential to the operation of the Department of Education and the  
34 public schools of this state; that in the event of an extension of the Regular  
35 Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1991 could  
36 work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of

1 essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared  
2 to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the  
3 public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and  
4 after July 1, 1991.
