For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND g OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE GOVERNOR'S MANSION COMMISSION 9 FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1993; AND FOR 10 OTHER PURPOSES." 11

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

15 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the 16 Governor's Mansion Commission for the 1991-93 biennium, the following maximum 17 number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions 18 of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 19 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, 20 however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set 21 out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform 22 Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions 23 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular 24 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its 25 successor.

18	SECTION 3. TRANSFER PROVISIONS. Any unexpended balance of any							
19	appropriation provided in this Act which remains at the close of the fiscal							
20	year ending June 30, 1992, shall be transferred forward and made available for							
21	1 the same purpose for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1993.

23	SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds							
24	authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency							
25	and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and							
	the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and							
	Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary							
28	Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control							
29	laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the							
30	Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be							
31	strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

33	SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General							
	Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations							
35	contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which							

1 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 2 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 3 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 4 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 5 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 7 SECTION 6. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent 8 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas 9 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 10 11 SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the 12 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such 13 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which 14 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this 15 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable. 16 17 SECTION 8. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict 18 with this Act are hereby repealed. 19 20 SECTION 9. HEALTH PREMIUMS. The Governor's Mansion Commission shall 21 not, during the 1992-93 fiscal year, spend more for health insurance per 22 employee than the amount being contributed to the State Employees Health 23 Insurance Program. 2.4 25 SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the 26 Seventy-Eighth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of 27 Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year 28 period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1991 is essential to the 29 operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, 30 and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the 31 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1991 could work irreparable harm 32 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 33 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act 34 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and

35 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1991.
