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SECTION 14. ADJUNCT AND VISITING PROFESSORS. The Southern Arkansas 4 University - Southwest Technical Institute Division shall be exempt from the 5 provisions of Arkansas Code §19-4-1707 to the extent that the Southern 6 Arkansas University - Southwest Technical Institute Division shall be allowed 7 to hire adjunct professors and visiting professors who are currently providing 8 professional and consulting services to the State of Arkansas, providing that 9 they are not in a position to influence decisions regarding the awarding of 10 grants or contracts, and providing that the term of their employment with the 11 Southern Arkansas University - Southwest Technical Institute Division does not 12 exceed 25% of that required for a full time employee.

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SECTION 15. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 14 15 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 16 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 17 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and 18 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 19 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditure Restrictions 20 Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where 21 applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and 22 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in 23 disbursement of said funds.

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25 SECTION 16. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 26 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 27 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which 28 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 29 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 30 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 31 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 32 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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34 SECTION 17. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and 35 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and 36 the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

1 SECTION 18. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the 3 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such 4 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which 5 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this 6 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable. 8 SECTION 19. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict 9 with this Act are hereby repealed. 1.0 11 SECTION 20. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the 12 Seventy-Eighth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of 13 Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year 14 period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1991 is essential to the 15 operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, 16 and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the 17 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1991 could work irreparable harm 18 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 19 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act 20 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and 21 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1991. 22 /s/John E.
