**A Bill ACT 1122 OF 1991**  
**HOUSE BILL 1861**

**For An Act To Be Entitled**

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND  
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR NORTH ARKANSAS COMMUNITY COLLEGE  
10 FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1993; AND FOR  
11 OTHER PURPOSES."  
12

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
14

15 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for North  
16 Arkansas Community College for the 1991-93 biennium, the following maximum  
17 number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions  
18 of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201  
19 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided,  
20 however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set  
21 out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform  
22 Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions  
23 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular  
24 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its  
25 successor.

SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditure Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive

1 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
2 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
3 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
4 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

6       SECTION 7. *If the Northwest Arkansas Community College Foundation, Inc.*  
7 *is required to refund to the North Arkansas Community College any voluntary*  
8 *taxes collected in Benton County and paid to the Foundation or its predecessor*  
9 *between June 30, 1986 and June 30, 1991, then the North Arkansas Community*  
10 *College shall transfer those funds to the Northwest Arkansas Community*  
11 *College.*

13       SECTION 8. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent  
14 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
15 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

16

17       SECTION 9. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the  
18 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
19 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
20 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
21 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

22

23       SECTION 10. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
24 with this Act are hereby repealed.

25

26       SECTION 11. ADJUNCT AND VISITING PROFESSORS. The North Arkansas  
27 Community College shall be exempt from the provisions of Arkansas Code §19-4-  
28 1707 to the extent that the North Arkansas Community College shall be allowed  
29 to hire adjunct professors and visiting professors who are currently providing  
30 professional and consulting services to the State of Arkansas, providing that  
31 they are not in a position to influence decisions regarding the awarding of  
32 grants or contracts, and providing that the term of their employment with the  
33 North Arkansas Community College does not exceed 25% of that required for a  
34 full time employee.

36       SECTION 12. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the

1 Seventy-Eighth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of  
2 Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year  
3 period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1991 is essential to the  
4 operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided,  
5 and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the  
6 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1991 could work irreparable harm  
7 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
8 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
9 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
10 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1991.
