REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the State 17 Department for Social Security Administration Disability Determination for the 18 1991-93 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees whose 19 salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and 20 Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all 21 laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a 22 specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt 23 from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. There is hereby appropriated, to the State 34 Department for Social Security Administration Disability Determination, to be 35 payable from the federal funds as designated by the Chief Fiscal Officer of 36 the State, for personal services and operating expenses of the State

The remaining balance as of June 30, 1992, of 17 18 unexpended appropriation in Capital Outlay shall be carried forward into 19 fiscal year 1992-93 to be used for the same purpose for the next fiscal year. SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 2.0 21 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 22 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 23 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and 24 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 25 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control 26 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the 27 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 28 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 29 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 30 31 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 32 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which 33 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 34 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 35 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 36 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative

         SECTION 6. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
 4 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
 5 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

         SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
 8 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
 9 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
10 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
11 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

         SECTION 8. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
14 with this Act are hereby repealed.

         SECTION 9. HEALTH PREMIUMS. The State Department for Social Security
16
17 Administration Disability Determination shall not, during the 1992-93 fiscal
18 year, spend more for health insurance per employee than the amount being
19 contributed to the State Employees Health Insurance Program.

         SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
2.1
22 Seventy-Eighth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of
23 Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year
24 period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1991 is essential to the
25 operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided,
26 and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the
27 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1991 could work irreparable harm
28 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
29 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
30 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
31 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1991.
