REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the 16 Arkansas Teacher Retirement System for the 1991-93 biennium, the following 17 maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the 18 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code 19 §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. 20 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary 21 is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said 22 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act.         SECTION 5. EXTRA HELP. The Teacher Retirement System is authorized to
10 pay extra help to work on the optical image system project. These positions
11 are utilized for a specific project and are specifically exempt from the
12 limitations either by act or regulation, of hours worked.
13

         SECTION 6. OVERTIME. The Teacher Retirement System is hereby
15 authorized to make overtime payments at the rate of 1-1/2 times their regular
16 pay to personnel who are engaged in activities of the special project, optical
17 image system conversion, which is a critical need. Such payments are to be
18 made only after a prior review by the Legislative Council. Such payments are
19 to be in addition to compensation otherwise due said employees at the rate
20 currently paid, but on an hourly basis. Such compensation, when added to an
21 employee's regular salary and benefits, shall not be construed as exceeding
22 the maximum annual salary as described in the General Accounting and Budgetary
23 Procedure Law.

        SECTION 7. CARRY FORWARD. The remaining balance as of June 30, 1992 of
26 unexpended appropriation for Overtime Pay, Extra Help, Capital Outlay and
27 Purchase of Data Processing, as authorized in Section 3 of this Act, shall be
28 carried forward and used for the same purposes in fiscal year 1992-93.

         SECTION 8. APPROPRIATIONS - CONSTRUCTION. There is hereby
31 appropriated, to the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System, to be payable from
32 the Teacher Retirement Fund, for the construction and equipping of a building
33 to house the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System and provide additional office

SECTION 9. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 2 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 3 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 4 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and 5 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 6 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control 7 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the 8 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 9 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 10 11 SECTION 10. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 12 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 13 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which 14 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 15 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 16 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 17 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 18 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 19 20 SECTION 11. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and 21 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and 22 the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 23 SECTION 12. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the 2.4 25 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such 26 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which 27 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this 28 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable. 29 SECTION 13. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict 30 31 with this Act are hereby repealed. 32 33 SECTION 14. HEALTH PREMIUMS. The Arkansas Teacher Retirement System 34 35 shall not, during the 1992-93 fiscal year, spend more for health insurance per

1 employee than the amount being contributed to the State Employees Health
 2 Insurance Program.
 3
         SECTION 15. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
 5 Seventy-Eighth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of
 6 Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year
 7 period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1991 is essential to the
 8 operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided,
 9 and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the
10 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1991 could work irreparable harm
11 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
12 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
13 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
14 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1991.
