A BILL ACT 1167 OF 1991
SENATE BILL 256

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 9-12-315 TO PROVIDE THAT
9 SOCIAL SECURITY DISABILITY BENEFITS ARE NOT MARITAL
10 PROPERTY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

13

14 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 9-12-315(b) is hereby amended to read as
15 follows:

16 "(b) For the purpose of this section, "marital property" means all
17 property acquired by either spouse subsequent to the marriage except:

18 (1) Property acquired prior to marriage, or by gift, or by
19 bequest, or by devise, or by descent;

20 (2) Property acquired in exchange for property acquired prior to
21 the marriage or in exchange for property acquired by gift, bequest, devise, or
22 descent;

23 (3) Property acquired by a spouse after a decree of divorce from
24 bed and board;

25 (4) Property excluded by valid agreement of the parties;

26 (5) The increase in value of property acquired prior to marriage
27 or by gift, bequest, devise, or descent, or in exchange therefor;

28 (6) Benefits received or to be received from a workers'
29 compensation claim, personal injury claim, or social security claim when those
30 benefits are for any degree of permanent disability or future medical
31 expenses; and

32 (7) Income from property owned prior to the marriage, or from
33 property acquired by gift, bequest, devise, or descent, or in exchange
34 therefor."

36 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature

1 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
2 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

3

4 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
5 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
6 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
7 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
8 act are declared to be severable.

9

10 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
11 hereby repealed.
