**A BILL ACT 121 OF 1991**  
**HOUSE BILL 1347**

**For An Act To Be Entitled**

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND  
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE WAR MEMORIAL STADIUM COMMISSION  
10 FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1993; AND FOR  
11 OTHER PURPOSES."

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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15 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the War  
16 Memorial Stadium Commission for the 1991-93 biennium, the following maximum  
17 number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions  
18 of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201  
19 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided,  
20 however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set  
21 out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform  
22 Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions  
23 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular  
24 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its  
25 successor.

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6 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the War  
7 Memorial Stadium Commission for the 1991-93 biennium, the following maximum  
8 number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help",  
9 payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: One hundred twenty-  
10 five (125) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not  
11 to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act,  
12 or its successor, for the appropriate classification.

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14 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the War  
15 Memorial Stadium Commission, to be payable from cash funds as defined by  
16 Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the War Memorial Stadium Commission, for personal  
17 services and operating expenses of the War Memorial Stadium Commission for the  
18 biennial period ending June 30, 1993, the following:

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1 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the War  
2 Memorial Stadium Commission, to be payable from the War Memorial Stadium  
3 Improvement and Expansion Fund, to be used to supplement monies raised by the  
4 issuance of revenue bonds for stadium improvement and expansion purposes, if  
5 authorized by law, for the biennial period ending June 30, 1993, the  
6 following:

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12 SECTION 5. EMPLOYMENT OF ATTORNEYS. None of the funds appropriated in  
13 this Act for Maintenance and General Operation shall be expended in payment  
14 for services of attorneys, unless the agency shall first make a request in  
15 writing to the Attorney General of the State of Arkansas to provide the  
16 required legal services. The Attorney General's Office shall provide the  
17 requested legal services, or, if the Attorney General's Office shall determine  
18 that sufficient personnel are not available to provide the requested legal  
19 services, the Attorney General shall certify the same to the agency and may  
20 authorize the agency to employ legal counsel and to expend monies appropriated  
21 for Maintenance and General Operations therefor, if:

22 (1) The Attorney General determines, and certifies in writing, that  
23 such agency needs the advice or assistance of legal counsel, and

24 (2) The Attorney General consents in writing to the employment of the  
25 legal counsel to be retained by the agency.

26 Such certification shall be required with respect to each instance of  
27 the employment of special legal counsel, or shall be required annually with  
28 respect to legal counsel employed on a retainer basis. A copy of such  
29 certification shall be entered in the official minutes of the agency, and  
30 shall be retained in the fiscal records of the agency for audit purposes.

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32 SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
33 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
34 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
35 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and

1 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
2 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control  
3 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the  
4 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
5 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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7       SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
8 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
9 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which  
10 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
11 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
12 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
13 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
14 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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16       SECTION 8. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent  
17 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
18 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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20       SECTION 9. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the  
21 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
22 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
23 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
24 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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26       SECTION 10. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
27 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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29       SECTION 11. HEALTH PREMIUMS. The War Memorial Stadium Commission shall  
30 not, during the 1992-93 fiscal year, spend more for health insurance per  
31 employee than the amount being contributed to the State Employees Health  
32 Insurance Program.

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34       SECTION 12. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
35 Seventy-Eighth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of

1 Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year  
2 period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1991 is essential to the  
3 operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided,  
4 and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the  
5 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1991 could work irreparable harm  
6 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
7 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
8 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
9 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1991.
