A BILL ACT 1235 OF 1991
SENATE BILL 718

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO REPEAL ARKANSAS CODE 8-7-226(c) TO CONTINUE THE
9 AUTHORITY FOR THE ARKANSAS DEPARTMENT OF POLLUTION CONTROL
10 AND ECOLOGY TO ASSESS AND COLLECT HAZARDOUS WASTE
11 MANAGEMENT FEES AFTER OCTOBER 1, 1991, SHOULD
12 AUTHORIZATION FOR ALL AVAILABLE COMPONENTS OF THE FEDERAL
13 RCRA PROGRAM FROM THE U.S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY
14 NOT BE RECEIVED."

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Annotated Section 8-7-226(c) is hereby
19 repealed.

21 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
22 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
23 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

25 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
26 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
27 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
28 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
29 act are declared to be severable.

30
31 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
32 hereby repealed.

33
34 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the General
35 Assembly that the effectiveness of this act on July 1, 1991, is essential to
36 the operation of the Hazardous Waste Management Program within the Department

1 of Pollution Control and Ecology and that in the event of an extension of the
2 Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this act beyond July 1,
3 1991, could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision
4 of the essential government programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby
5 declared to exist and this act being necessary for the immediate preservation
6 of the public peace, health and safety shall be in effect from and after July
7 1, 1991.
