**A BILL ACT 135 OF 1991**  
**SENATE BILL 44**

**For An Act To Be Entitled**

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 4 OF UNCODIFIED ACT 944 OF 1981,  
9 AS AMENDED, TO INCREASE THE MAXIMUM SALARY FOR CASE  
10 COORDINATORS IN THE EIGHTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT; AND FOR OTHER  
11 PURPOSES."

12  
13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

14  
15 SECTION 1. Section 4 of uncodified Act 944 of 1981, as amended, is  
16 hereby amended to read as follows:

17 "Section 4. The salary and expenses to paid each clerk-secretary-case  
18 coordinator within the Eighth Circuit shall be not less than twelve thousand  
19 six hundred dollars (\$12,600) per year nor more than twenty-five thousand  
20 dollars (\$25,000) per year."

21  
22 SECTION 2. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature  
23 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
24 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

25  
26 SECTION 3. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to  
27 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
28 other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without  
29 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
30 Act are declared to be severable.

31  
32 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are  
33 hereby repealed.

34  
35 SECTION 5. Emergency. It is hereby found and determined by the General  
36 Assembly that the maximum annual salary for the clerk-secretary-case

1 coordinator of the Eighth Judicial Circuit is inadequate; that the counties  
2 cannot increase the salary until the maximum prescribed is increased; and that  
3 this Act increases that maximum salary and thereby gives the counties the  
4 flexibility of determining a reasonable salary for that position. Therefore,  
5 an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act being necessary for the  
6 immediately preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in  
7 full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
