**For An Act To Be Entitled**

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND  
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE ARKANSAS GEOLOGICAL COMMISSION  
10 FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1993; AND FOR  
11 OTHER PURPOSES."

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

15 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby  
16 established for the Arkansas Geological Commission - State Operations for the  
17 1991-93 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees whose  
18 salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and  
19 Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all  
20 laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a  
21 specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt  
22 from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All  
23 persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the  
24 provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas  
25 Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

23 SECTION 10. EXTRA HELP - EARTHQUAKE STUDY. There is hereby authorized,  
24 for the Arkansas Geological Commission - Earthquake Study for the 1991-93  
25 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to  
26 be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such  
27 purposes: Three (3) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates  
28 of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and  
29 Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate  
30 classification.

31

32 SECTION 11. APPROPRIATIONS - EARTHQUAKE STUDY. There is hereby  
33 appropriated, to the Arkansas Geological Commission - Earthquake Study, to be  
34 payable from the Geology Lignite Characteristic Study Federal Fund, for extra  
35 help and operating expenses of the Arkansas Geological Commission - Earthquake

16 SECTION 12. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
 17 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
 18 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
 19 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and  
 20 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
 21 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control  
 22 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the  
 23 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
 24 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

25

26 SECTION 13. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
 27 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
 28 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which  
 29 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
 30 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
 31 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
 32 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
 33 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

35 ~~SECTION 14. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and~~

1 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and  
2 the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

3

4 SECTION 15. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the  
5 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
6 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
7 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
8 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

9

10 SECTION 16. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
11 with this Act are hereby repealed.

12

13 SECTION 17. HEALTH PREMIUMS. The Arkansas Geological Commission shall  
14 not, during the 1992-93 fiscal year, spend more for health insurance per  
15 employee than the amount being contributed to the State Employees Health  
16 Insurance Program.

17

18 SECTION 18. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
19 Seventy-Eighth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of  
20 Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year  
21 period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1991 is essential to the  
22 operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided,  
23 and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the  
24 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1991 could work irreparable harm  
25 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
26 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
27 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
28 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1991.
