SENATE BILL 325

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR FOR THE
10 BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1993; AND FOR OTHER
11 PURPOSES."

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

15 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - DEPARTMENT OF LABOR - OPERATIONS. There
16 is hereby established for the Department of Labor for the 1991-93 biennium,
17 the following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be
18 governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act
19 (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory
20 thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum
21 annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the
22 provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons
23 occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of
24 the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-
25 101), or its successor.

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22 SECTION 7. None of the funds appropriated in the Act shall be used for
23 professional services contracts to employ private security guard firms.

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25 SECTION 8. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
26 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
27 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
28 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
29 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
30 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control
31 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the
32 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
33 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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35 SECTION 9. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General

1 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
2 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which
3 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
4 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
5 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
6 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
7 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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9 SECTION 10. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and
10 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and
11 the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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13 SECTION 11. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
14 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
15 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
16 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
17 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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19 SECTION 12. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
20 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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22 SECTION 13. HEALTH PREMIUMS. The Department of Labor shall not, during
23 the 1992-93 fiscal year, spend more for health insurance per employee than the
24 amount being contributed to the State Employees Health Insurance Program.

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26 SECTION 14. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
27 Seventy-Eighth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of
28 Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year
29 period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1991 is essential to the
30 operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided,
31 and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the
32 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1991 could work irreparable harm
33 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
34 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
35 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and

1 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1991.
