# A Bill ACT 207 OF 1991

## SENATE BILL 327

### For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND  
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE ARKANSAS CRIME INFORMATION  
10 CENTER FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1993; AND  
11 FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

15 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the  
16 Arkansas Crime Information Center for the 1991-93 biennium, the following  
17 maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the  
18 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code  
19 §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.  
20 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary  
21 is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said  
22 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions  
23 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular  
24 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its  
25 successor.

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16 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Arkansas  
 17 Crime Information Center for the 1991-93 biennium, the following maximum  
 18 number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help",  
 19 payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: three (3) temporary  
 20 or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those  
 21 provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor,  
 22 or this act for the appropriate classification.

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24 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the  
 25 Arkansas Crime Information Center, to be payable from the Crime Information  
 26 System Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the Arkansas  
 27 Crime Information Center for the biennial period ending June 30, 1993, the

17 persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the

18 provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas

19 Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

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13 SECTION 8. APPROPRIATIONS - CAREER CRIMINAL PROSECUTION PROGRAM -

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33 SECTION 9. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds

34 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency

35 ~~and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations, and~~

1 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and  
2 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
3 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control  
4 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the  
5 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
6 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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8       SECTION 10. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
9 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
10 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which  
11 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
12 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
13 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
14 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
15 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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17       SECTION 11. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and  
18 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and  
19 the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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21       SECTION 12. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the  
22 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
23 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
24 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
25 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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27       SECTION 13. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
28 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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30       SECTION 14. HEALTH PREMIUMS. The Arkansas Crime Information Center  
31 shall not, during the 1992-93 fiscal year, spend more for health insurance per  
32 employee than the amount being contributed to the State Employees Health  
33 Insurance Program.

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35       SECTION 15. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the

1 Seventy-Eighth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of  
2 Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year  
3 period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1991 is essential to the  
4 operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided,  
5 and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the  
6 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1991 could work irreparable harm  
7 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
8 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
9 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
10 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1991.
