A Bill ACT 288 OF 1991

HOUSE BILL 1885

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES MAY
9 APPOINT HOUSE ALTERNATES TO THE JOINT BUDGET COMMITTEE AS
10 SOON AS HOUSE BILL 1148 OF THE SEVENTY-EIGHTH GENERAL
11 ASSEMBLY IS PASSED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND SIGNED BY
12 THE GOVERNOR; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

15

16 SECTION 1. The Speaker of the House of Representatives is hereby
17 authorized to appoint House alternate members of the Joint Budget Committee as
18 authorized in House Bill 1148 of the Seventy-Eighth General Assembly as soon
19 as House Bill 1148 is passed by both houses of the General Assembly and signed
20 by the Governor.

22 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
23 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
24 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

26 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
27 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
28 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
29 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
30 act are declared to be severable.

31

32 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
33 hereby repealed.

34

35 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the General
36 Assembly that the original purpose of House Bill 1148 of the Seventy-Eighth

1 General Assembly was to provide for the appointment of alternates to the House
2 members of the Joint Budget committee and to authorize the Speaker to make
3 such appointments as soon as possible; that House Bill 1148 was passed without
4 an emergency clause; that this act is designed to specifically authorize the
5 Speaker to make the House appointments as soon as House Bill 1148 is signed by
6 the Governor and should be given effect immediately. Therefore, an emergency
7 is hereby declared to exist and this act being necessary for the preservation
8 of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from
9 and after its passage and approval.
