REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the Fire 16 Extinguisher Board for the 1991-93 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the 18 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et 19 seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, 20 that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein 21 in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification 22 and Compensation Act. - SECTION 3. EMPLOYMENT OF ATTORNEYS. None of the funds appropriated in
- 20 this Act for Maintenance and General Operation shall be expended in payment
- 21 for services of attorneys, unless the agency shall first make a request in
- 22 writing to the Attorney General of the State of Arkansas to provide the
- 23 required legal services. The Attorney General's Office shall provide the
- 24 requested legal services, or, if the Attorney General's Office shall determine
- 25 that sufficient personnel are not available to provide the requested legal
- 26 services, the Attorney General shall certify the same to the agency and may
- 27 authorize the agency to employ legal counsel and to expend monies appropriated
- 28 for Maintenance and General Operations therefor, if:
- 29 (1) The Attorney General determines, and certifies in writing, that
- 30 such agency needs the advice or assistance of legal counsel, and
- 31 (2) The Attorney General consents in writing to the employment of the
- 32 legal counsel to be retained by the agency.
- 33 Such certification shall be required with respect to each instance of
- 34 the employment of special legal counsel, or shall be required annually with
- 35 respect to legal counsel employed on a retainer basis. A copy of such
- 36 certification shall be entered in the official minutes of the agency, and

1 shall be retained in the fiscal records of the agency for audit purposes. 2. SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 4 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 5 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 6 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and 7 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 8 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control 9 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the 10 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 11 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 12 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 13 14 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 15 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which 16 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 17 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 18 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 19 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 20 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 21 22 SECTION 6. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent 23 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas 24 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 25 SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the 26 27 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such 28 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which 29 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this 30 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable. 31 SECTION 8. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict 32 33 with this Act are hereby repealed.

1 during the 1992-93 fiscal year, spend more for health insurance per employee 2 than the amount being contributed to the State Employees Health Insurance 3 Program. 5 SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the 6 Seventy-Eighth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of 7 Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year 8 period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1991 is essential to the 9 operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, 10 and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the 11 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1991 could work irreparable harm 12 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 13 programs.
