For An Act To Be Entitled

9 *"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 10-3-1303 CONCERNING THE*
10 *DUTIES OF THE JOINT COMMITTEE ON CHILDREN AND YOUTH DURING*
11 *SESSIONS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."*

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

15 *SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 10-3-1303 is amended to read as follows:*

16 *"10-3-1303. Duties. The Joint Committee on Children and Youth shall*
17 *make continuing studies and shall cooperate with the appropriate agencies of*
18 *this state, agencies of the United States Government, and the Congress of the*
19 *United States in the exchange and dissemination of information and in the*
20 *development of legislation designed to coordinate planning and to try new ways*
21 *to prevent young people from falling through the cracks."*

23 *SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are*
24 *hereby repealed.*

25

26 *SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature*
27 *are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code*
28 *Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.*

29

30 *SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to*
31 *any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect*
32 *other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without*
33 *the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this*
34 *act are declared to be severable.*
