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For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND VARIOUS SECTIONS OF CHAPTER 23 OF TITLE
9 20 OF THE ARKANSAS CODE OF 1987 TO INCREASE THE FEES
10 CHARGED BY THE BOILER INSPECTION DIVISION OF THE ARKANSAS
11 DEPARTMENT OF LABOR FOR SHOP INSPECTIONS AND SPECIAL
12 INSPECTIONS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

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14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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16 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 20-23-305 is hereby amended to read as
17 follows:

18 "20-23-305. Special inspection.

19 If at any time the owner, user, or agent of the owner of any boiler
20 within the state shall desire a special inspection of any boiler, it shall be
21 made by the Boiler Inspection Division after due request thereof. The
22 inspector making the inspection shall collect a fee of one hundred dollars
23 (\$100) for each boiler together with his expenses from Little Rock to the
24 place of inspection and return."

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26 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 20-23-311(a) is hereby amended to read as
27 follows:

28 "(a) There shall be paid for the annual inspection of each boiler by
29 the Boiler Inspection Division made according to the provisions of this
30 chapter, within thirty (30) days from the date of inspection, the sum as
31 follows:

32 (1) BOILERS:

33 (A) Up to and including 15 horsepower, incl.....\$10.00

34 (B) Over 15 horsepower to 50 horsepower, incl..... 13.00

35 (C) Over 50 horsepower to 100 horsepower, incl..... 18.00

36 (D) Over 100 horsepower to 150 horsepower, incl..... 20.00 (E)

1	Over 150 horsepower to 250 horsepower, incl.....	23.00	(F)
2	Over 250 horsepower to 500 horsepower, incl.....	35.00	(G)
3	Over 500 horsepower	50.00	(2)
4	SHOP INSPECTIONS: per day, four hundred and forty dollars (\$440); per half		
5	day, two hundred and twenty dollars (\$220); plus expenses including mileage,		
6	not to exceed the rate authorized by the General Assembly to employees of		
7	state agencies, who furnish their own transportation, and meals and lodging in		
8	accordance with that approved by the General Assembly as a daily allowance.		
9	(3) UNFIRED PRESSURE VESSELS:		
10	(A) 150 gallons or less	\$9.00	
11	(B) 151 gallons to 500 gallons	10.00	
12	(C) 501 gallons to 1,000 gallons	11.00	(D)
13	1,001 gallons to 2,000 gallons	12.00	(E)
14	2,001 gallons to 3,000 gallons	13.00	(F)
15	3,001 gallons to 5,000 gallons	14.00	(G)
16	5,001 gallons and over	18.00"	

17 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code 20-23-402(e) is hereby amended to read as
 18 follows:

19 "(e) If annual reports are not filed with the Boiler Inspection
 20 Division by insurance companies who have insurance on boilers in the State of
 21 Arkansas within sixty (60) days from the date they are due inspection, the
 22 Boiler Inspection Division shall make the required inspection. A special
 23 inspection fee of one hundred dollars (\$100) for each boiler or unfired
 24 pressure vessel inspected, plus mileage and expenses from Little Rock to point
 25 of inspection and return, not to exceed the current rate authorized by the
 26 General Assembly to employees of state agencies who furnish their own
 27 transportation, plus any meals and hotel bills incurred, shall be charged to
 28 the insurance company insuring the boilers or unfired pressure vessels unless
 29 an extension of time is granted by the chief inspector."

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31 SECTION 4. Arkansas Code 20-23-405(f) is hereby amended to read as
 32 follows:

33 "(f) The provisions of §§ 20-23-104, 20-23-307 - 20-23-309, and
 34 20-23-403 -20-23-405 shall not apply to firms under the regulations of the
 35 Interstate Commerce Commission."

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SECTION 5. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 6. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 7. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
