For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES,
9 OPERATING EXPENSES AND PAYMENT OF CLAIMS FOR THE OFFICE OF
10 ATTORNEY GENERAL WHICH SHALL BE SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN
11 ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS APPROPRIATED BY ACT 46 OF THE
12 FIRST EXTRAORDINARY SESSION OF 1989, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR
13 ENDING JUNE 30, 1991; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

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15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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17 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Office
18 of Attorney General, to be payable from the State Central Services Fund, for
19 personal services and operating expenses of the Office of Attorney General
20 which shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds appropriated in
21 Section 3 of Act 46 of the First Extraordinary Session of 1989, for the
22 remainder of the fiscal year ending June 30, 1991, the following:

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7 SECTION 5. APPROPRIATIONS - MEDICAID FRAUD DIVISION - FEDERAL. There

8 is hereby appropriated, to the Office of Attorney General, to be payable from

9 the Attorney General Federal Fund in the State Treasury, for personal services

10 of the Office of Attorney General - Medicaid Fraud Division - Federal which

11 shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds appropriated in Section

12 11 of Act 46 of the First Extraordinary Session of 1989, for the remainder of

13 the fiscal year ending June 30, 1991, the following:

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19 SECTION 6. APPROPRIATIONS - MEDICAID FRAUD DIVISION - STATE. There is

20 hereby appropriated, to the Office of Attorney General, to be payable from the

21 State Central Services Fund, for personal services of the Office of Attorney

22 General - Medicaid Fraud Division - State which shall be supplemental and in

23 addition to those funds appropriated in Section 12 of Act 46 of the First

24 Extraordinary Session of 1989, for the remainder of the fiscal year ending

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31 SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds

32 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency

33 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and

34 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and

35 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary

1 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control
2 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the
3 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
4 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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6 SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
7 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
8 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which
9 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
10 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
11 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
12 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
13 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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15 SECTION 9. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
16 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
17 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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19 SECTION 10. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
20 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
21 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
22 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
23 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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25 SECTION 11. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
26 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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28 SECTION 12. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
29 Seventy-Eighth General Assembly, that funds provided by the Seventy-Seventh
30 General Assembly for the operations of the Office of Attorney General are, due
31 to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the Office of Attorney General
32 to continue to provide essential governmental services; that the provisions of
33 this act will provide the necessary monies for the Office of Attorney General
34 to continue such services; and that a delay in the effective date of this Act
35 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of

1 essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared
2 to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the
3 public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and
4 after the date of its passage and approval.
