# A Bill ACT 595 OF 1991

## SENATE BILL 539

### For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND  
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR GARLAND COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE  
10 FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1993; AND FOR  
11 OTHER PURPOSES."

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

14  
15 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for Garland  
16 County Community College for the 1991-93 biennium, the following maximum  
17 number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions  
18 of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201  
19 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided,  
20 however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set  
21 out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform  
22 Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions  
23 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular  
24 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its  
25 successor.

SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for Garland County Community College for the 1991-93 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: three hundred thirty five (335) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and

1 Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate  
 2 classification.

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4 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS - GENERAL REVENUE. There is hereby  
 5 appropriated, to Garland County Community College, to be payable from the  
 6 Garland County Community College Fund, for personal services and operating  
 7 expenses of Garland County Community College for the biennial period ending  
 8 June 30, 1993, the following:

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24 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATIONS - CASH FUNDS. There is hereby appropriated,  
 25 to Garland County Community College, to be payable from cash funds as defined  
 26 by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of Garland County Community College, for personal  
 27 services and operating expenses of Garland County Community College for the  
 28 biennial period ending June 30, 1993, the following:

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12 SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
 13 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
 14 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
 15 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and  
 16 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
 17 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditure Restrictions  
 18 Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where  
 19 applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and  
 20 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in  
 21 disbursement of said funds.

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23 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
 24 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
 25 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which  
 26 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
 27 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
 28 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
 29 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
 30 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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32 SECTION 7. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent  
 33 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
 34 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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36 SECTION 8. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the

1 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
2 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
3 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
4 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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6 SECTION 9. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
7 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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9 SECTION 10. ADJUNCT AND VISITING PROFESSORS. The Garland County  
10 Community College shall be exempt from the provisions of Arkansas Code §19-4-  
11 1707 to the extent that the Garland County Community College shall be allowed  
12 to hire adjunct professors and visiting professors who are currently providing  
13 professional and consulting services to the State of Arkansas, providing that  
14 they are not in a position to influence decisions regarding the awarding of  
15 grants or contracts, and providing that the term of their employment with the  
16 Garland County Community College does not exceed 25% of that required for a  
17 full time employee.

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19 SECTION 11. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
20 Seventy-Eighth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of  
21 Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year  
22 period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1991 is essential to the  
23 operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided,  
24 and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the  
25 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1991 could work irreparable harm  
26 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
27 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
28 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
29 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1991.
