**A BILL ACT 678 OF 1991**  
**HOUSE BILL 1922**

**For An Act To Be Entitled**

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 26-18-304 TO SPECIFY TIME  
9 REQUIREMENTS FOR NOTICE OF TERMINATION OF BONDS SECURING  
10 PAYMENT OF TAX; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

13

14 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 26-18-304 is hereby amended to read as  
15 follows:

16 "26-18-304. Approval of bonds.

17 (a) Any bond required by any state tax law shall be subject to the  
18 approval of the director as to form, sufficiency, value, amount, stability,  
19 and other features necessary to provide a guarantee of payment of the tax due  
20 the state under this chapter.

21 (b) Where a bond is required for the purpose of insuring any state tax  
22 law, and written notice of termination is required before the bond can be  
23 terminated, the party issuing the bond cannot be required to provide the  
24 written notice of termination more than sixty (60) days prior to the date the  
25 bond is to be terminated.

26 (c) The length of time required for the notice of termination shall be  
27 calculated from the date of receipt of the notice of termination, rather than  
28 the date of mailing.

29 (d) The term bond shall mean any bond, letter of credit or assignment  
30 of a certificate of deposit."

31

32 SECTION 2. The provisions of the act shall become effective of January  
33 1, 1992.

34

35 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
36 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code

1 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

3 SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
4 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
5 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
6 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
7 act are declared to be severable.

8

9 SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
10 hereby repealed.
