12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

14	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 5-36-103(b)(3) is hereby amended to read as
15	follows:
16	"(3) Theft of property is a Class C felony if the property is
17	livestock, and the value of the livestock is in excess of two hundred dollars
18	(\$200.00)."
19	
20	SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
21	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
22	Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
23	
24	SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
25	any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
26	other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
27	the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
28	act are declared to be severable.

3 0	SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
31	hereby repealed.
