Arkansas Code §27-16-701 is hereby amended by adding a new 17 subsection to read as follows: "(f)(1) Any person less than eighteen (18) years old who is unable to 18 19 meet the requirements of subsection (d) above may petition the Office of 20 Driver Services that he or she be issued a restricted operator permit for 21 employment-related purposes. (2) The Office of Driver Services shall advise the person of the 22 23 time and place for making such request and for the hearing thereon, which 24 shall be conducted within a reasonable time following the application date. 25 (3) Such notice shall be given by mailing the notice to the last 26 known address of the person seeking the restricted operator permit. (4) (A) In cases where demonstrable financial hardship would 2.7 28 result from the failure to issue a learner's permit or driver's license, the 29 Department of Finance and Administration may grant exceptions only to the 30 extent necessary to ameliorate the hardship. 31 If it can be demonstrated that the conditions for granting 32 a hardship were fraudulent, the parent, guardian, or person in loco parentis 33 shall be subject to all applicable perjury statutes. The Department of Finance and Administration shall have the 34 35 power to promulgate rules and regulations to carry out the intent of this

36 section and shall distribute to each public, private, and parochial school a

1	copy of all rules and regulations adopted under this section.
2	
3	SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
4	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
5	Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
6	
7	SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
8	any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
9	other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
10	the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
11	act are declared to be severable.
12	
13	SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
14	hereby repealed.
