7 **For An Act To Be Entitled**

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 23-112-403(2) (K) AND (Q)  
9 AND 27-14-207, RELATING TO MOTOR HOMES; AND FOR OTHER  
10 PURPOSES."

11  
12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

13  
14 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 23-112-403(2) (K) and (Q) are hereby amended to  
15 read as follows:

16 "(K) Notwithstanding the terms of any franchise agreement, fails to pay  
17 to a dealer or any lienholder in accordance with their respective interests  
18 after the termination of franchise, the dealer cost plus any charges by the  
19 manufacturer, distributor, or a representative for distribution, delivery, and  
20 taxes, less all allowances paid to the dealer by the manufacturer,  
21 distributor, or representative for new, unsold, undamaged, and complete motor  
22 vehicles and motor homes of current model year and one (1) year prior model  
23 year in the dealer's inventory;"

24 "(Q) The terms and conditions of subdivision (K) shall not apply to  
25 manufacturers of mobile homes and motor homes, as defined in 27-14-207, when  
26 dealers of mobile homes and motor homes undertake to terminate, cancel or fail  
27 to renew an agreement."

28  
29 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 27-14-207 is hereby amended by adding a new  
30 subdivision to read as follows:

31 "(g) 'Motor home' means a motor vehicle designed to provide temporary  
32 living quarters, built onto an integral part of, or permanently attached to a  
33 self propelled motor vehicle chassis. The vehicle must contain permanently  
34 installed independent life support systems."

35  
36 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature

1 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
2 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

4 SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
5 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
6 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
7 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
8 act are declared to be severable.

9

10 SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
11 hereby repealed.
