**For An Act To Be Entitled**

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND  
9 OPERATING EXPENSES OF A SPECIAL DEPUTY PROSECUTING  
10 ATTORNEY FOR THE ELEVENTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT FOR THE  
11 BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1993; AND FOR OTHER  
12 PURPOSES."

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

16 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the  
17 Eleventh Judicial District for the 1991-93 biennium, the following maximum  
18 number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions  
19 of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201  
20 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided,  
21 however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set  
22 out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform  
23 Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions  
24 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular  
25 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its  
26 successor.

36 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Auditor

1 of State, to be payable from the Constitutional Officers Fund, for personal  
2 services and operating expenses of the Special Deputy Prosecuting Attorney of  
3 the Eleventh Judicial District for the biennial period ending June 30, 1993,  
4 the following:

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13 SECTION 3. The Special Deputy Prosecuting Attorney for the Eleventh  
14 Judicial District shall be available to provide services to any other Judicial  
15 District in the State in which State penal facilities are located or in which  
16 State penal matters are involved, when called upon by the Prosecutor of any  
17 such Judicial District.

19 SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
20 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
21 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
22 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and  
23 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
24 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control  
25 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the  
26 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
27 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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29 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
30 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
31 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which  
32 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
33 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
34 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
35 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative

1 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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3 SECTION 6. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent  
4 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
5 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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7 SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the  
8 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
9 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
10 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
11 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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13 SECTION 8. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
14 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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16 SECTION 9. HEALTH PREMIUMS. The Auditor of State shall not, during the  
17 1992-93 fiscal year, spend more for health insurance per employee than the  
18 amount being contributed to the State Employees Health Insurance Program.

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20 SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
21 Seventy-Eighth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of  
22 Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year  
23 period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1991 is essential to the  
24 operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided,  
25 and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the  
26 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1991 could work irreparable harm  
27 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
28 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
29 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
30 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1991.
