**For An Act To Be Entitled**

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND  
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE OFFICE OF PROSECUTOR  
10 COORDINATOR FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1993;  
11 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

15 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the  
16 Office of Prosecutor Coordinator for the 1991-93 biennium, the following  
17 maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the  
18 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code  
19 §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.  
20 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary  
21 is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said  
22 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions  
23 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular  
24 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its  
25 successor.

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25 SECTION 12. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized

26 by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds

27 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the

28 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary

29 Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures

30 and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of

31 this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of

32 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied

33 with in disbursement of said funds.

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35 SECTION 13. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly

1 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
2 in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this Act  
3 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
4 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
5 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
6 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint  
7 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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9 SECTION 14. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent  
10 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
11 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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13 SECTION 15. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the  
14 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
15 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
16 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
17 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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19 SECTION 16. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
20 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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22 SECTION 17. HEALTH PREMIUMS. The Office of Prosecutor Coordinator shall  
23 not, during the 1992-93 fiscal year, spend more for health insurance per  
24 employee than the amount being contributed to the State Employees Health  
25 Insurance Program.

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27 SECTION 18. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
28 Seventy-Eighth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of  
29 Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year  
30 period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1991 is essential to the  
31 operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided,  
32 and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the  
33 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1991 could work irreparable harm  
34 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
35 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act

1 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
2 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1991.
