11 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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12 SECTION 26. APPROPRIATIONS - NONPOINT SOURCE POLLUTION CONTROL PROGRAM.

13 There is hereby appropriated, to the Soil and Water Conservation Commission,

 15 of the State, for personal services and operating expenses of the Soil and
 16 Water Conservation Commission - Nonpoint Source Pollution Control Program for

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34 SECTION 27. TRANSFER PROVISION. At the end of each fiscal year, the
 35 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall authorize the transfer of obligated

1 water, sewer, and solid waste funds, as provided in the 1991-93 biennial
2 appropriation act for the Soil and Water Conservation Commission in the
3 appropriation entitled "WATER, SEWER AND SOLID WASTE - STATE", from the State
4 General Services Fund Account, to the Water, Sewer and Solid Waste Revolving
5 Fund.

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7 SECTION 28. Any unexpended balance of the appropriation authorized for
8 Disbursements for Water Projects Construction in Item (04) of Section 10 of
9 this Act which remains at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992,
10 shall be carried forward and made available for the same purpose for the
11 fiscal year ending June 30, 1993.

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13 SECTION 29. Any unexpended balance of the appropriation authorized for
14 Disbursements for Pollution Abatement Projects Construction in Item (04) of
15 Section 6 of this Act which remains at the close of the fiscal year ending

 32 SECTION 33. At the beginning of each fiscal year, the Chief Fiscal
 33 Officer of the State may authorize the transfer of funds in the amount
 34 appropriated for the Southeast Arkansas Study to the Soil and Water
 35 Conservation Commission in this Act from monies available in the General

1 *Improvement Fund to the State General Services Fund Account.*

3 SECTION 34. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
4 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
5 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
6 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
7 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary

22 SECTION 36. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and
23 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and
24 the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

26 SECTION 37. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
27 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
28 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
29 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
30 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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32 SECTION 38. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
33 with this Act are hereby repealed.
