Arkansas Code Title 27, Chapter 15 is amended by adding the 15 following new section: "27-15-2601. United States Merchant Marine License Plate. Each Arkansas resident, who is a retired veteran of the United 17 18 States Merchant Marine, is entitled to register one (1) automobile, as defined 19 by § 27-14-601(a)(1), or one (1) Class One truck, as defined by §27-14-20 601(a)(3), and receive a special Retired United States Merchant Marine license 21 plate. The license plate shall be of standard color and design as is 22 currently issued by the Department of Finance and Administration, except that 23 in lieu of the legend 'The Natural State', it shall have placed across the 24 bottom thereof a permanent decal bearing the words 'Retired US Veteran' and 25 the letters 'USMM'. The license plate shall be issued by the Department of Finance and 26 27 Administration upon application containing a copy of the certificate of 28 release (Form DD 214) or certificate issued pursuant to Public Law 87, 78th 29 Congress as verification that the applicant served in the United States 30 Merchant Marines during the period of October 1, 1940 through December 31, 31 1945, and is therefore qualified to receive all applicable veterans benefits. (c) The applicant shall pay the regular fee for license plates as 33 prescribed by law. The Director of the Department of Finance and Administration may 34 35 adopt reasonable regulations necessary to carry out the purposes of this

2	SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
3	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
4	Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

6	SECTION 3. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to
7	any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
8	other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without
9	the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
10	Act are declared to be severable.

12	SECTION 4. All laws or parts of laws in conflict with this act are
13	hereby repealed.
