L9	(a) No child shall be admitted to any public school of the state until

21	school authorities an official copy of that child's birth certificate and
22	provides that child's social security number. Provided, however, a parent or
23	guardian that objects to the listing of his or her child's social security
24	number on school records may have this requirement waived by signing a
25	notarized statement regarding their objections.
26	(b) School authorities may provisionally admit a child for whom an
27	official birth certificate or social security number has not been provided if:
8 2	(1) In the case of the birth certificate, other proof of the
29	child's date of birth is submitted along with a completed and postage paid

31	for the birth certificate fee to the school authorities so that an official
