For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR -
10 EMPLOYMENT SECURITY DIVISION FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD
11 ENDING JUNE 30, 1993; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

14
15 SECTION 1.1.1 REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby
16 established for the Department of Labor - Employment Security Division for the
17 1991-93 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees whose
18 salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and
19 Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all
20 laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a
21 specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt
22 from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All
23 persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the
24 provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas
25 Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

SECTION 1.1.2 EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Department of Labor - Employment Security Division for the 1991-93 biennium,

1 the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known

 3 four hundred (400) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of
 4 pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and
 5 Compensation Act, or its successor, for the appropriate classification. Any
 6 of these positions utilized in a manner which are funded by federal sources
 7 are specifically exempt from limitation of hours, either by Act or Regulation.

6 SECTION 1.1.4 "REED ACT FUNDS". There is hereby appropriated out of

7 funds made available to this State under Section 903 of the Social Security

8 Act, as amended, the sum of \$5,000,000, or so much thereof as may be

9 necessary, to be used, under the direction of the Employment Security

10 Division, for the purpose of construction and improvement of buildings,

11 rent/lease costs, acquisition of data processing equipment, acquisition of

12 land and/or for the payment of salaries and related benefits of local office

13 staff of the Employment Security Division for the biennial period ending June

14 30, 1993.

16 The amount obligated pursuant to this Act shall not exceed the amount by which

17 (a) the aggregate of the amounts transferred to the account of this State

SECTION 14. ADDITIONAL POSITIONS. The Administrator of the Employment Security Division, after receiving the approval of the Office of Personnel Management, and after seeking the prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council, shall have the authority to establish such new or additional full time positions as may become necessary to carry out the objectives of the program and/or to meet Federal requirements of new and/or expanded programs where such needs are financed by federal funds; provided that not more than two hundred persons may be employed in addition to those authorized in the salary schedule and that the rate of pay shall not exceed those set out in the

1 salary schedule for comparable positions as authorized under the provisions of
2 Section 1 of this Act.

3

4 SECTION 15. TRANSFER OF APPROPRIATION. Subject to such rules and
5 regulations as may be implemented by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and
6 after having sought the prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council, the
7 Administrator of the Employment Security Division is hereby authorized to make
8 transfers from any appropriation made by this Act to any other appropriation
9 made by this Act with the exception of the "Reed Act Funds" appropriations set
10 forth in Section 4 of this Act, and of the appropriation made for Regular
11 Salaries or Maintenance and General Operation. Such transfers may be made
12 whenever it appears, by projecting the expenditures of any of the
13 appropriations in this Act, that there will be a deficiency of appropriation
14 in one item and that there will be a corresponding excess of appropriation in
15 another item or items which may be transferred. The transfer of appropriation
16 shall be effected only on approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State.
17 Provided, however, that no transfer of appropriations may be authorized to
18 increase the total amount appropriated for Regular Salaries, or Maintenance
19 and General Operations, except as may be authorized elsewhere by law.

20

21 SECTION 16. CARRY FORWARD. Any unexpended balance of appropriation
22 made by this Act, with the exception of appropriation made for Regular
23 Salaries and Maintenance and General Operation, which remains at the close of
24 the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992, shall be transferred forward and made
25 available for the same purpose for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1993.

26

27 SECTION 17. REPORTING. The Employment Security Division shall report
28 quarterly to the Arkansas Legislative Council the number of registrants or
29 recipients of Food Stamps interviewed, the number of job referrals made, and
30 the number of registrants or recipients of Food Stamps placed in jobs. This
31 report shall be made for each county or district office; provided the
32 Employment Security Division has federal funds available and specifically
33 identified for use in providing such services.

34

35 SECTION 18. RESTRICTIONS. Upon approval and implementation of the

1 Office of Personnel Management's (OPM) classification recommendations of
 2 September 17, 1984, to be effective July 1, 1985, incumbents who occupied
 3 specified positions in the following recommended classifications or titles on
 4 or before September 17, 1984, and who remain in those classifications and/or
 5 specified positions, shall continue to be paid at the grade authorized for
 6 that classification and position which was in effect on June 30, 1985.

7 Employees who entered these classifications and/or specified positions after
 8 September 17, 1984, shall be paid at the OPM recommended classification and
 9 pay grade, as specified below:

11 SECTION 19. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
 12 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
 13 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
 14 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
 15 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
 16 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control
 17 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the
 18 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
 19 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

20

21 SECTION 20. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
 22 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
 23 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which
 24 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
 25 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
 26 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
 27 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
 28 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

29

30 SECTION 21. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and
 31 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and
 32 the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

33

34 SECTION 22. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
 35 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such

1 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
2 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
3 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

4

5 SECTION 23. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
6 with this Act are hereby repealed.

7

8 SECTION 24. HEALTH PREMIUMS. The Department of Labor - Employment
9 Security Division shall not, during the 1992-93 fiscal year, spend more for
10 health insurance per employee than the amount being contributed to the State
11 Employees Health Insurance Program.

12

13 SECTION 25. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
14 Seventy-Eighth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of
15 Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year
16 period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1991 is essential to the
17 operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided,
18 and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the
19 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1991 could work irreparable harm
20 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
21 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
22 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
23 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1991.
