For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE SALARIES OF THE SECRETARY-COURT
9 REPORTER-CASE COORDINATORS OF THE FOURTH JUDICIAL
10 DISTRICT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

14 SECTION 1. Ark. Code Ann. §16-13-1204 is hereby amended to read as
15 follows:

16 "16-13-1204. Secretary-court reporter-case coordinators.

17 (a) (1) The chancellors of the Fourth Judicial District may each employ
18 one (1) secretary-court reporter-case coordinator to perform secretarial,
19 court reporter, and case coordinator duties as may be assigned by the
20 respective chancellors.

21 (2) The circuit judges of the Fourth Judicial District may each
22 employ one (1) secretary-court reporter-case coordinator to perform
23 secretarial, court reporter, and case coordinator duties as may be assigned by
24 the respective circuit judges.

25 (3) The Circuit-Chancery Judge, Juvenile Division may employ a
26 secretary-court reporter-case coordinator to perform secretarial, court
27 reporter and case coordinator duties as may be assigned by the Circuit-
28 Chancery Judge, Juvenile Division.

29 (b) The secretaries authorized by this section shall be appointed by
30 the respective chancellors or circuit judges, shall be sworn officers of the
31 court, and shall hold office at the discretion of the chancellor or circuit
32 judge during the term of the judge who appointed him, except that he may be
33 dismissed for incompetency, neglect of duty, or misbehavior.

34 (c) The secretaries authorized by this section shall each be paid a
35 salary for calendar year 1991 of \$18,339.50 and an annual salary each year
36 thereafter of \$19,715.00 payable by the counties comprising the Fourth

1 Judicial District. The salaries shall be apportioned between the two (2)
2 counties on the basis of the assessed value of property in the counties which
3 is determined to be ninety-three and one-half percent (93.5%) for Washington
4 County and six and one-half percent (6.5%) for Madison County, and in the
5 following amounts: 1991

9		\$18,339.50	\$19,715.00

10 The salaries shall be payable in equal bi-monthly installments by the
11 paying offices of the respective counties."

12
13 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
14 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
15 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

16
17 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
18 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
19 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
20 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
21 act are declared to be severable.

23 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
24 hereby repealed.
