HOUSE BILL 1900

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS FOR
10 MEDICAL SCIENCES FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30,
11 1993; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

15 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
16 University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences for the 1991-93 biennium, the
17 following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed
18 by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas
19 Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.
20 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary
21 is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said
22 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions
23 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular
24 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its
25 successor.

24 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the
 25 University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences for the 1991-93 biennium, the
 26 following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as
 27 "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: Four
 28 hundred fifty (450) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of

36 SECTION 9. ARKANSAS CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL. Thirty-three and one-third

1 percent (33-1/3%) in each fiscal year of the biennial period ending June 30,
 2 1993, of the amounts made available to fund the appropriation in Item (03) of
 3 Section 6 of this Act shall be distributed to the Arkansas Children's
 4 Hospital.

5

6 SECTION 10. SPECIAL ALLOWANCES. The Board of Trustees may make special
 7 allowances available, in such amounts as the Board may determine or justify
 8 equitable in view of the exacting duties which are involved, as a part of the
 9 salaries of the physicians and dentists employed by the College of Medicine of
 10 the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences, for their additional duties
 11 in attending patients through auspices of the University of Arkansas for
 12 Medical Sciences, these allowances to be paid by the Board of Trustees from
 13 auxiliary income of the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences from
 14 receipts of professional income in the care of patients. Provided that any
 15 such allowance shall not exceed, for any employee, an amount equal to two (2)
 16 times that portion of the salary authorized by the General Assembly to be paid
 17 from the University of Arkansas Medical Center Fund.

18

19 SECTION 11. SPECIAL ALLOWANCES. The Board of Trustees of the University
 20 of Arkansas is hereby authorized to make available to the President of the
 21 University of Arkansas special allowances in such amounts as the Board may
 22 determine to be justified at the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences,
 23 for the use of the Chancellor and his deans, representatives, department
 24 heads, and directors at the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences in
 25 recruitment of faculty and staff members. Upon approval by the President and
 26 the Board of Trustees, such funds shall be administered by the Chancellor, who
 27 shall assure that the total amount expended for such purposes does not exceed
 28 one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) each fiscal year or so much thereof as
 29 may be authorized by the Board of Trustees. The funds authorized by this
 30 Section shall come from a source other than state tax dollars appropriated by
 31 the General Assembly or charges made to students for tuition, fees, room and
 32 board, or other purposes. Each year the Chancellor shall furnish to the
 33 President of the University of Arkansas, the Board of Trustees, and the
 34 Arkansas Legislative Joint Auditing Committee a report showing for each
 35 expenditure the date, the amount, the names of persons to whom the expenditure

1 was made, and the purpose for which the expenditure was made.

2

3 SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE AND RESTRICTIONS - AREA HEALTH EDUCATION
4 CENTERS. The positions authorized under the heading "TWELVE-MONTH-AHEC" of
5 Section 1 of this Act shall be utilized exclusively for the implementation and
6 operation of the Area Health Education Centers (AHEC) to be administered by
7 the Chancellor of the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences. The
8 Chancellor at the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences shall make
9 periodic progress reports of AHEC programs to the Governor, the Legislative
10 Council, and other interested interim committees of the General Assembly
11 regarding the achievements, the expansion of the aforementioned programs, and
12 amounts expended for the Area Health Education Centers.

13

14 SECTION 13. CONTRACT RESTRICTIONS (PHYSICIAN TEACHERS AND TEACHERS IN
15 OTHER HEALTH RELATED PROFESSIONS) AREA HEALTH EDUCATION CENTERS. Funds
16 appropriated by this Act may be utilized for the purpose of contracting with
17 physician-teachers and teachers in other health related professions residing
18 only at sites located away from the University of Arkansas for Medical
19 Sciences. Such funds are to be paid only for the purpose of teaching
20 residents and students assigned to Area Health Education Centers. Contracts
21 entered into with physician-teachers, teachers in other health related fields
22 and their associates shall require the prior approval of the Chief Fiscal
23 Officer of the State only and be reported quarterly to the Legislative
24 Council.

25

26 SECTION 14. SPECIAL PROVISIONS FOR UNCLASSIFIED PATIENT CARE PERSONNEL.
27 All unclassified positions employed to provide patient care at the University
28 of Arkansas for Medical Sciences are eligible for overtime at the rate of one
29 and one-half times their regular hourly rate. In addition to overtime, those
30 unclassified patient care employees scheduled to work shifts outside of normal
31 operating schedules may be eligible to receive up to twenty-four (24) percent
32 of the hourly rate paid as a shift differential. In addition, all
33 unclassified positions employed to provide patient care at the University of
34 Arkansas for Medical Sciences will be eligible to receive incentive pay not to
35 exceed 1.2 times their base hourly rate. Employees required to be available

1 for duty on nights, weekends and holidays will be eligible to receive standby
 2 pay equivalent of up to four hours of work per shift. Employees required to
 3 work in specialty areas will be eligible to receive up to ten (10) percent of
 4 the hourly rate paid as a specialty differential while working in such areas.
 5 When overtime, shift differentials, standby pay, incentive pay and/or
 6 specialty differential are provided to employees as herein described, the
 7 total may exceed the line item maximum salaries for those positions as
 8 included in this Act. The positions of Patient Care Administrator, Associate
 9 Administrator, and Assistant Administrator of Patient Care as authorized in
 10 Section 1 of this Act shall be excluded from coverage of this Section.

11

12 SECTION 15. DAY CARE. Of the funds appropriated in Section 6 of this
 13 Act, \$250,000 each year of the biennium may be allocated as the State's
 14 portion of the operating cost of a Child Care Facility for use by personnel of
 15 the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences and the Department of Human
 16 Services - Mental Health Division, with nursing personnel given first
 17 priority. Personnel using this facility will be charged a daily rate as
 18 determined by the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences.

19

20 SECTION 16. CARRY FORWARD. Any unexpended balance of the appropriations
 21 and funds provided by this Act which remains at the close of the fiscal year
 22 ending June 30, 1992, not to exceed ten percent (10%) of funded
 23 appropriations, shall be carried forward and made available for the same
 24 purpose for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1993.

25

26 SECTION 17. STIPENDS. The University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences
 27 is hereby authorized to pay stipends to students engaged in post-graduate
 28 clinical training in accredited programs of the University of Arkansas for
 29 Medical Sciences, from "Regular Salaries" or "Maintenance and General
 30 Operation", as follows:

4 SECTION 18. ADMISSION POLICY. The University of Arkansas for Medical
 5 Sciences shall admit one hundred fifty (150) freshman students in each year of
 6 the 1991-93 biennium into the College of Medicine. Provided that no funds
 7 shall be expended to fund the positions of Chancellor, Dean of Medicine and
 8 any academic position until the Chancellor and Dean of Medicine certify to the
 9 Arkansas Legislative Council that the provision of this Section relating to
 10 the 1991-93 biennium requirement for one hundred fifty (150) freshman student
 11 admissions has been implemented.

12

13 SECTION 19. The Chancellor of the University of Arkansas for Medical
 14 Sciences may designate up to forty-five per cent (45%) of the regular gross
 15 salary (or stipend) of a minister or other clergy employed as a Chaplain or
 16 appointed as a Chaplain Resident, as a housing allowance, to the extent used
 17 by the person to rent or provide a home, according to the guidelines of the
 18 Internal Revenue Service Code, Section 107 and the Arkansas Code §26-51-
 19 404(11).

20

21 SECTION 20. ADJUNCT AND VISITING PROFESSORS. The University of Arkansas
 22 for Medical Sciences shall be exempt from the provisions of Arkansas Code §19-
 23 4-1707 to the extent that the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences
 24 University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences shall be allowed to hire adjunct
 25 professors and visiting professors who are currently providing professional
 26 and consulting services to the State of Arkansas, providing that they are not
 27 in a position to influence decisions regarding the awarding of grants or
 28 contracts, and providing that the term of their employment with the University
 29 of Arkansas for Medical Sciences does not exceed 25% of that required for a
 30 full time employee.

31

32 SECTION 21. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
 33 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
 34 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
 35 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and

1 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
2 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditure Restrictions
3 Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where
4 applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and
5 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in
6 disbursement of said funds.

7
8 SECTION 22. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
9 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
10 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which
11 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
12 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
13 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
14 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
15 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

16
17 SECTION 23. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and
18 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and
19 the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

20
21 SECTION 24. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
22 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
23 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
24 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
25 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

26
27 SECTION 25. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
28 with this Act are hereby repealed.

29
30 SECTION 26. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
31 Seventy-Eighth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of
32 Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year
33 period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1991 is essential to the
34 operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided,
35 and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the

1 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1991 could work irreparable harm
2 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
3 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
4 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
5 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1991.
