"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 3-6-104 TO PROVIDE THAT
NATIVE BRANDY MANUFACTURERS MAY SELL NATIVE BRANDY AT
RETAIL ON THE MANUFACTURERS_ PREMISES; AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

"PROVIDE THAT NATIVE BRANDY MANUFACTURERS MAY SELL NATIVE BRANDY AT RETAIL ON THE MANUFACTURERS_ PREMISES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 3-6-104(h) is amended to read as follows:
"(h) The holder of a permit shall be authorized to manufacture the products defined in §3-6-102 and to sell them, without the necessity of obtaining any further license or permit, to the holders of bona fide wholesale or retail liquor permits issued in the manner now provided by law and may sell the products to the holders of permits to manufacture native wines in this state. Manufacturer shall be authorized to sell such products at retail on the premises of the authorized place of manufacture."

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.
