Arkansas Code 3-6-104(h) is amended to read as follows: 19 20 "(h) The holder of a permit shall be authorized to manufacture the 21 products defined in §3-6-102 and to sell them, without the necessity of 22 obtaining any further license or permit, to the holders of bona fide wholesale 23 or retail liquor permits issued in the manner now provided by law and may sell 24 the products to the holders of permits to manufacture native wines in this 25 state. Manufacturer shall be authorized to sell such products at retail on 26 the premises of the authorized place of manufacture." 27 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature 2.8 29 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code 30 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 31 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to 32 33 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect 34 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 35 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this 36 act are declared to be severable.
