20	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Annotated 4-74-111 is amended to read as
23	follows:
24	"(a) It is unlawful for any person, firm, corporation, association, or
25	other business entity to falsely represent that the person or entity is going
26	out of business or for any person or entity to misrepresent the ownership of a
27	business for the purpose of or in connection with the conduct of a going out
28	of business sale.
29	(b) Any going out of business sale conducted in violation of this
30	chapter shall constitute an unfair or deceptive act or practice as defined by
31	the Deceptive Trade Practices Act, Arkansas Code 4-88-101 et seq. All
32	remedies, penalties, and authority granted to the Attorney General under the
33	Deceptive Trade Practices Act shall be available to the Attorney General for
34	the enforcement of this act."

36	SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent

1 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas 2 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to 5 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect 6 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 7 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this 8 act are declared to be severable. SECTION 4 . All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are 11 hereby repealed. APPROVED: 07/12/93
