22	this state shall be entitled to be enrolled in and to attend school in either	
23	the district in which the parent or guardian resides or the district in which	
24	the parent or guardian is a public school teacher or any district located in	
25	the county in which the main office of the educational co-operative is	
26	located.	
27	However, beginning with the 1993-94 school year, no student may transfe	r
28	to a nonresident district where the percentage of enrollment for the student'	S

         SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
 4 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect

         SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are

         SECTION 5. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the General

13 Assembly that uncertainty exists as to what conditions will justify attendance
14 by a student in a nonresident district and in order to clarify those
15 conditions the General Assembly hereby finds that an emergency exists.
16 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this act being
17 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
18 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and
19 approval.
