# A Bill

**ACT 1116 OF 1993**  
**HOUSE BILL 1834**

## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 17-30-210 (a) (2) (A) AND 17-  
9 30-210 (b) RELATING TO BOND AND INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS OF  
10 CERTAIN PEST CONTROL LICENSEES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

13 "BOND AND INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS FOR PEST CONTROL  
14 LICENSEES."

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 17-30-210 (a) (2) (A) is amended to read as  
19 follows:

20 "(2) (A) The bond shall be executed by the applicant as principal and by  
21 a surety company licensed to do business in this state in the surety amount of  
22 five thousand dollars (\$5,000)."

24 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 17-30-210 (b) is amended to read as follows:

25 "(b) Insurance. In addition to the bond required in subsection (a) (1),  
26 before a license is issued or renewed, each applicant for a license in either  
27 the classification of termite and other structural pests, the classification  
28 of household pests and rodent control, or the classification of general  
29 fumigation shall furnish the board a certificate of insurance written by an  
30 insurance company authorized to do business in this state, covering the public  
31 liability of the applicant for personal injuries for not less than twenty-five  
32 thousand dollars (\$25,000) for any one (1) person, and fifty thousand dollars  
33 (\$50,000) for any one (1) accident and not less than five thousand dollars  
34 (\$5,000) property damage."

36 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature

1 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
2 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

4 SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
5 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
6 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
7 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
8 act are declared to be severable.

9

10 SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
11 hereby repealed.
