REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the State 20 Military Department - Civilian Student Training Program for the 1993-95 21 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries 22 shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and 23 Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all 24 laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a 25 specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt 26 from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. SECTION 3. Juvenile participants in the Civilian Student Training 2 Program at Camp Joseph T. Robinson receiving services from the Arkansas 3 National Guard are authorized to receive a monetary stipend, not to exceed ten 4 dollars (\$10.00) per week to defray personal hygiene and other personal 5 necessities. Juvenile participants are authorized to receive uniforms and 6 clothing items as determined by the staff to be appropriate for effective 7 participation in outdoor activities. 9 SECTION 4. Transportation to support Civilian Student Training program 10 activities for juvenile participants and staff may be provided by commercial 11 lease of motor vehicles not to exceed two (2) five (5) passenger sedans and 12 four (4) fifteen passenger vans. 13 14 SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 15 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 16 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 17 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and 18 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 19 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control 20 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the 21 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 22 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 23 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 2.4 25 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 26 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which 27 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 28 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 29 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 30 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 31 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 32 33 CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent 34 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas 35 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

2	SECTION 8. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
3	application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
4	invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
5	can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
6	end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.
7	
8	SECTION 9. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
9	with this Act are hereby repealed.
10	
11	SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
12	Seventy-Ninth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas
13	prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that
14	the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1993 is essential to the operation of
15	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
16	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
17	date of this Act beyond July 1, 1993 could work irreparable harm upon the
18	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
19	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
20	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
21	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1993.
