SENATE BILL 730

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO CREATE THE DELTA PARKWAY TASK FORCE; AND FOR
9 OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

12 "AN ACT TO CREATE THE DELTA PARKWAY TASK FORCE."

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

16 SECTION 1. (a) There is created the Delta Parkway Task Force.

17 (b) The Task Force shall be composed of nine (9) members to be selected
18 as follows:

19 (1) one (1) member of the State Parks, Recreation and Travel
20 Commission to be appointed by the chairman of the commission;

21 (2) one (1) member of the State Highway Commission to be
22 appointed by the chairman of the commission;

23 (3) two (2) members of the House of Representatives to be
24 appointed by the Speaker of the House;

25 (4) two (2) members of the Senate to be appointed by the
26 President Pro Tempore of the Senate; and

27 (5) three (3) members to be appointed by the Governor who shall be
28 residents of Monroe County or Phillips County.

29 (c) The members of the Task Force shall select a chairman.

30 (d) The members of the Task Force shall serve without compensation.

31
32 SECTION 2. The Delta Parkway Task Force shall investigate the
33 possibility of developing a beautification plan for the Delta Parkway which
34 begins at the intersection of Arkansas State Highway 49 and the Interstate 40
35 exit at Brinkley and ends at the Helena Bridge located on the Arkansas-
36 Mississippi border. The Task Force shall report its findings to the Governor

1 and the Arkansas General Assembly by January 1, 1995.

2

3 SECTION 3. The Delta Parkway Task Force shall expire on January 1,
4 1995.

5

6 SECTION 4. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
7 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
8 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

9

10 SECTION 5. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
11 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
12 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
13 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
14 act are declared to be severable.

15

16 SECTION 6. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
17 hereby repealed.
