## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND  
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH FOR THE  
10 BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1995; AND FOR OTHER  
11 PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

14 "AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH APPROPRIATION."

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby  
19 established for the Department of Health for the 1993-95 biennium, the  
20 following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed  
21 by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas  
22 Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.  
23 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary  
24 is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said  
25 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions  
26 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular  
27 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its  
28 successor.

18 SECTION 34. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Health,  
19 to be payable from the Public Health Fund, for personal services of the

29 SECTION 35. One A111 Accountant Grade 18 position and one R168 Grants  
30 Coordinator II position established in Section 13 herein shall be funded from  
31 general revenues accruing to the Public Health Fund, from the appropriation  
32 provided in Section 34 herein for the Office of Rural Health Services.

33

34 SECTION 36. (a) It is hereby recognized that sexual activity by  
35 students places our youth at increased risk of pregnancy and the contraction



1 of AIDS and other sexually transmitted diseases, and it is the policy of the  
2 state of Arkansas to discourage such sexual activity. The school board of  
3 every school district which associates itself with distributing, recommending,  
4 or prescribing condoms or contraceptives shall adopt a resolution  
5 acknowledging that there are risks associated with teen sexual activities. It  
6 is further required that every public school and public health department sex  
7 education and AIDS prevention program shall emphasize premarital abstinence as  
8 the only sure means of avoiding pregnancy, and the sexual contraction of AIDS  
9 and other sexually transmitted diseases.

10 (b) Arkansas Code Annotated 6-18-703(a)(1) is amended as follows:

11 "(a)(1). No school-based health clinic may be established in a public  
12 school until requested by resolution by the school board of directors, and no  
13 child shall receive school-based health clinic services without parental  
14 consent. Parental consent to contraceptive services and condom distribution  
15 shall be specific, in writing, and maintained in the student's health records.  
16 All school-based clinics shall maintain accurate records of distributing and  
17 prescribing of contraceptives and condoms. The number of pregnancies and  
18 sexually transmitted diseases among students in the schools with school-based  
19 clinics shall be transmitted annually to the school board of directors.  
20 Records maintained under this section are part of the confidential medical  
21 record of the student. Numerical or statistical data required to be  
22 maintained under this section may not be released in a manner which reveals  
23 the identity of or any other information contained in the file of the  
24 student."

25

26 SECTION 37. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
27 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
28 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
29 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and  
30 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
31 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control  
32 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the  
33 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
34 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

35

1 SECTION 38. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
2 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
3 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which  
4 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
5 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
6 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
7 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
8 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

9

10 SECTION 39. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and  
11 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the  
12 Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

13

14 SECTION 40. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the  
15 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
16 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
17 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
18 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

19

20 SECTION 41. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
21 with this Act are hereby repealed.

22

23 SECTION 42. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
24 Seventy-Ninth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas  
25 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that  
26 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1993 is essential to the operation of  
27 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
28 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
29 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1993 could work irreparable harm upon the  
30 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
31 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
32 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
33 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1993.
