19	"(29)(a) The gross receipts proceeds charged to a consumer or user for								
20	the transfer of fill material by a business engaged in transporting or								
21	delivering fill material, provided:								
22	(1) such fill material was obtained free of charge by a business engaged								
23	in transporting or delivering fill material, and								
24	(2) the charge to the consumer or user is only for delivery.								
25	(b) Any business claiming the exemption under subsection (a) shall keep								
26	suitable records necessary to determine that fill material was obtained								
27	without charge.

29	SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature								
30	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code								
31	Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

33	SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to								
34	any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect								
35	other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without								
36	the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
