## **For An Act To Be Entitled**

8 *"AN ACT TO REQUIRE APPLICANTS FOR WORKERS' COMPENSATION TO*  
9 *DIVULGE CHILD SUPPORT OBLIGATIONS; AND FOR OTHER*  
10 *PURPOSES."*

## **Subtitle**

12  
13 *"AN ACT TO REQUIRE APPLICANTS FOR WORKERS' COMPENSATION TO*  
14 *DIVULGE CHILD SUPPORT OBLIGATIONS."*

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18 *SECTION 1. At any time an application is made for Workers'*  
19 *Compensation, an employer shall require the applicant for compensation to*  
20 *state whether or not the applicant has child support obligations, if the*  
21 *obligations are current or past due, and to whom the obligations are payable.*  
22 *The employer shall forward a copy of the application to the Arkansas Child*  
23 *Support Enforcement Unit, Division of Economic and Medical Services,*  
24 *Department of Human Services. The application shall also include the name of*  
25 *the Workers' Compensation carrier and the name of the employer.*

26

27 *SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature*  
28 *are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code*  
29 *Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.*

30

31 *SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to*  
32 *any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect*  
33 *other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without*  
34 *the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this*  
35 *act are declared to be severable.*

1 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
2 hereby repealed.
