HOUSE BILL 1100

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 *"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE §7-6-203 (g) CONCERNING THE*
9 *PERIODS OF TIME IN WHICH IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL FOR CERTAIN*
10 *ELECTIVE OFFICERS TO ACCEPT CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTIONS; AND*
11 *FOR OTHER PURPOSES."*

Subtitle

14 *"AN ACT CONCERNING PERIODS OF TIME IN WHICH IT SHALL BE*
15 *UNLAWFUL FOR CERTAIN ELECTIVE OFFICERS TO ACCEPT CAMPAIGN*
16 *CONTRIBUTIONS."*

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 *SECTION 1. Arkansas Code §7-6-203 (g) is amended to read as follows:*

21 *"(g) (1). It shall be unlawful for the Governor, Lieutenant Governor,*
22 *Secretary of State, State Treasurer, Auditor of State, Attorney General,*
23 *Commissioner of State Lands, and members of the General Assembly to accept a*
24 *contribution:*

25 *(A) during the period beginning thirty (30) days before and*
26 *ending thirty (30) days after any regular session of the General Assembly.*
27 *However, if there is an extended recess of the General Assembly the period*
28 *shall end thirty (30) days after the beginning of the recess;*

29 *(B) during any extended session of the General Assembly; or*

30 *(C) during any special session of the General Assembly.*

31 *(2) During such periods of time, it shall be unlawful for any*
32 *person to promise a contribution to the aforementioned elected officials."*

34 *SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature*
35 *are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code*
36 *Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.*

SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstances is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
