	contribution limits shall continue to apply.

	are for the purpose of retiring a campaign debt. Any invitation to or notice
	of a fund raiser to retire a campaign debt of a previous campaign shall state
	that the funds are to retire a campaign debt."

12	any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
13	other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
14	the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
15	act are declared to be severable.
