Arkansas Code § 10-3-1601 is hereby amended to read as 23 24 follows: 25 "10-3-1601. Creation - Members. (a) To assist the General Assembly, there is established the Joint 26 27 Interim Oversight Committee on Higher Education Reform to be composed of the 28 following members: 29 (1) Seven (7) members of Arkansas Senate to be appointed by the 30 President Pro Tempore, in consultation with the Chairman of the Senate 31 Education Committee; and (2) Seven (7) members of Arkansas House of Representatives to be 32 33 appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives, in consultation with 34 the Chairman of the House Education Committee. (b) In making their appointments, the President Pro Tempore and the 35 36 Speaker shall seek to ensure that members who are knowledgeable about all

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٦ (c) The committee shall be assisted by staff provided by the Bureau of 4 Legislative Research. (d) Members of the committee shall be entitled to receive per diem and 5 6 expenses for their attendance at committee meetings at the same rate as 7 members of the General Assembly receive for attendance of joint interim 8 committees. 9 (e) The members appointed to the committee shall select a Senate co-10 chairman and a House co-chairman who shall serve for a two-year term during 11 the interim." 12 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 10-3-1101(a), as amended by Act 517 of 1993, 13 14 is amended to read as follows: 15 "(a) There is established a joint interim committee of the Senate and 16 House of Representatives of the General Assembly, to be known as the 'Joint 17 Interim Committee on Legislative Facilities' to consist of fourteen (14) 18 members of the General Assembly, as follows: 19 (1) The Chairman of the House Joint Budget Committee; 20 Two (2) members of the House of Representatives selected in (2)21 accordance with House Rules; 22 (3) The Chairman of the House Management Committee and two (2) 23 additional members of the House Management Committee to be designated by its 24 chairman; 25 (4) The Speaker of the House of Representatives; 26 (5) The President Pro Tempore of the Senate; The Chairman of the Senate Joint Budget Committee; 27 (6) (7) One member of the Senate appointed by the President Pro 28 29 Tempore of the Senate; and 30 (8) Four members of the Senate to be appointed by the Chairman of 31 the Senate Efficiency Committee." 32 33 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature 34 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code 35 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to 3 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect 4 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 5 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this 6 act are declared to be severable.
