## **For An Act To Be Entitled**

8 "AN ACT TO EXTEND THE FUNCTIONS AND DUTIES OF THE ARKANSAS  
9 GAME AND FISH COMMISSION FUNDING STUDY SUBCOMMITTEE UNTIL  
10 THE 80TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## **Subtitle**

13 "TO EXTEND THE FUNCTIONS AND DUTIES OF THE ARKANSAS GAME  
14 AND FISH COMMISSION FUNDING STUDY SUBCOMMITTEE."

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18 SECTION 1. The Arkansas Game and Fish Commission Funding Study  
19 Subcommittee shall continue to examine the funding needs of the Game and Fish  
20 Commission and shall make any necessary recommendations for legislation to the  
21 Governor and to the 80th General Assembly.

23 *SECTION 2. The Speaker of the House may appoint two (2) members of the*  
24 *House of Representatives as additional members to the Arkansas Game and Fish*  
25 *Commission Funding Study Subcommittee. One (1) additional member shall be*  
26 *female and one (1) member shall be a member of a racial minority. The*  
27 *President Pro Tempore of the Senate may appoint two (2) additional members of*  
28 *the Arkansas Senate as additional members to the Arkansas Game and Fish*  
29 *Commission Funding Study Subcommittee.*

31 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
32 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
33 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

35 SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
36 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect

1 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
2 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
3 act are declared to be severable.

5 SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
6 hereby repealed.
