14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

16	SECTION 1. (a)(1) The following boards and commissions shall have the			
17	power to issue subpoenas and bring before the board or commission as a witness			
18	any person in this state:

- 5 (2) These boards shall by regulation provide for the issuance of
- 6 a subpoena upon the request of any party to a proceeding pending before the
- 7 board or at the request of the board.
- 8 (3) The writ shall be in the name of the board, shall state the
- 9 name of the board and the name of the proceeding and shall command each person
- 10 to whom it is directed to appear and give testimony at the time and place
- 11 therein specified.
- 12 (4) The writ may require the witness to bring with him any book,
- 13 writing, or other thing under his control which he is bound by law to produce
- 14 in evidence.
- 15 (5) Service of the writ shall be in the manner as now provided
- 16 by statute or rule for the service of subpoenas in civil cases.
- 17 (b) (1) A witness who has been served by subpoena in the manner
- 18 provided by law and who shall have been paid or tendered the legal fees for
- 19 travel and attendance as provided by law shall be obligated to attend for
- 20 examination of the trial or cause pending before the board.
- 21 (2) In the event a witness shall have been served with subpoenas
- 22 as herein provided and fails to attend the hearing in obedience to the
- 23 subpoena, the board may apply to the circuit court of the county wherein the
- 24 board is having its meeting for an order causing the arrest of the witness and
- 25 directing that the witness be brought before the court.
- 26 (3) The court shall have the power to punish the disobedient
- 27 witness for contempt as provided by the Arkansas Rules of Civil Procedure.
- 28 (c) This act is intended to be supplemental and add the power to issue
- 29 subpoenas to the various chapters of the code which do not now provide the
- 30 power to do so; this act shall not repeal any law or part of laws now in
- 31 existence.

- 33 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
- 34 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
- 35 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

         SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
 3 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
 4 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
 5 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
 6 act are declared to be severable.

         SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
 9 hereby repealed.
