14	"AN ACT TO REQUIRE BACKGROUND CHECKS OF PERSONS SEEKING A
15	LICENSE OR EMPLOYMENT AT A CHILD CARE FACILITY.
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17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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19	SECTION 1. Child Abuse Central Registry Check - Owners, Operators,
20	Prospective Employees.
21	(a) The name of each applicant for a license to own or operate child
22	care facility and the name of each person seeking employment in a licensed
23	child care facility shall be checked with the Arkansas Child Abuse Central
24	Registry for reports of child abuse/neglect or maltreatment.
25	(b) The Child Care Facilities Review Board shall have the authority to
26	deny a license to any applicant found to have any record of founded child
27	abuse/neglect or maltreatment in the official record of the Arkansas Child
28	Abuse Central Registry.
29	(c) Any person seeking employment in a licensed child care facility
30	found to have any record of child abuse/neglect or maltreatment in the
31	official record of the Arkansas Child Abuse Central Registry shall be reviewed
32	by the owner/operator of the facility in consultation with the board to
33	determine appropriate corrective action measures which would include but are
34	not limited to training, probationary employment or nonselection for
35	employment.
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SECTION 2. Criminal Records Check - Owners, Operators.

2 (a) Each applicant for a license to own or operate a child care 3 facility shall be required to apply to the Identification Bureau of the 4 Arkansas State Police for a nationwide criminal records check, to be conducted 5 by the Federal Bureau of Investigation. The check shall conform to the 6 applicable federal standards and shall include the taking of fingerprints. 7 Such applicant shall sign a release of information and shall be responsible 8 for the payment of any fee associated with the criminal records check.

9 (b) Upon completion of the criminal records check, the *Identification* 10 *Bureau* of the State Police shall forward all information obtained concerning 11 the applicant for a license to the Child Care Facilities Review Board. 12

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SECTION 3. Criminal Records Check - Employees.

(a) Any person seeking employment, if that employment involves supervisory or disciplinary power over a child or children, or involves routine contact with a child or children, in any child care facility which is required to be licensed by the board, shall apply to the *Identification Bureau* of the Arkansas State Police for a nationwide criminal records check, to be conducted through the Federal Bureau of Investigation. The check shall conform to the applicable federal standards and shall include the taking of fingerprints. Upon applying for a criminal records check, such person shall sign a release of information and shall be responsible for the payment of any fee associated with the check.

(b) Upon completion of the criminal records check, the *Identification Bureau* of the State Police shall forward all information obtained concerning the person seeking employment in a child care facility to *the Child Care Facilities Review Board*.

(c) The owner or operator of a child care facility shall maintain on file, subject to inspection by the board, evidence that criminal records checks have been initiated on all employees seeking employment after September 1, 1993, and the results of the checks. Failure to maintain that evidence on file will be prima facia grounds to revoke the license of the owner or operator of the child care facility.

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35 SECTION 4. Destruction of Fingerprint Records.

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1 At the conclusion of any background check required by this act, the 2 Identification Bureau of the Arkansas State Police shall promptly destroy the 3 fingerprint card of the applicant or employee. 4 5 SECTION 5. Qualification for Child Care Employment. 6 No person shall be eligible to be a child care facility owner, operator, 7 or employee if that person has been found guilty of any of the following 8 offenses by any court in the State of Arkansas, or in any other state: (1) 9 Capital murder as prohibited in Arkansas Code 5-10-101; (2) Murder in the first and second degrees as prohibited in Arkansas 10 11 Code 5-10-102 and 5-10-103; Manslaughter as prohibited in Arkansas Code 5-10-104; 12 (3) (4) Battery in the first and second degrees as prohibited in Arkansas 13 14 Code 5-13-201 and 5-13-202; 15 (5) Aggravated assault as prohibited in Arkansas Code 5-13-204; 16 (6) Terroristic threatening in the first degree as prohibited in 17 Arkansas Code 5-13-301; (7) Kidnapping as prohibited in Arkansas Code 5-11-102; 18 19 False imprisonment in the first degree as prohibited in Arkansas (8) 20 Code 5-11-103; 21 (9) Permanent detention or restraint as prohibited in Arkansas Code 5-22 11-106; (10) Rape and carnal abuse in the first and second degrees as prohibited 23 24 in Arkansas Code 5-14-103 - 5-14-105; 25 (11) Sexual abuse in the first and second degrees as prohibited in 26 Arkansas Code 5-14-108 and 5-14-109; (12) Violation of a minor in the first and second degrees as prohibited 27 28 in Arkansas Code 5-14-120 and 5-14-121; (13) Incest as prohibited in Arkansas Code 5-26-202; 29 (14) Endangering the welfare of a minor in the first degree as 30 31 prohibited in Arkansas Code 5-27-203; (15) Permitting child abuse as prohibited in subdivisions (a)(1) and 32 33 (a) (3) of Arkansas Code 5-27-221; (16) Engaging children in sexually explicit conduct for use in visual or 34 35 print medium, transportation of minors for prohibited sexual conduct, use of a

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1 child or consent to use of a child in sexual performance, by producing, 2 directing, or promoting sexual performance by a child as prohibited in 3 Arkansas Code 5-27-303, 5-27-305, 5-27-402, and 5-27-403; and (17) Criminal attempt, criminal solicitation, or criminal conspiracy as 4 5 prohibited in Arkansas Code 5-3-201, 5-3-202, 5-3-301 and 5-3-401 to commit 6 any of the offenses listed in this subsection. 7 SECTION 6. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent 8 9 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas 10 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 11 12 SECTION 7. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to 13 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect 14 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 15 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this 16 act are declared to be severable. 17 18 SECTION 8.
